Project Progress

A survey was done among at least ten stakeholders who used drones either as part of their profession as a journalist, media or as a hobby, in all partner countries. Several interviews were conducted and a desktop survey was also done. The results from these surveys and interviews were analysed and presented in a document together with an overview of the current regulations and laws governing the use of drones in all partner countries. Apart from the National reports, done by each partner, a transnational comparative report with the results of all partner countries was also done. Then, this transnational report was translated into all partners' languages which will be available at the project webpage.

A framework for the development has been developed by the Result leader with the support of the co-leader. A design of the main potential contents has been defined and shared with the partners. A plan with contents and division of tasks among the partners has been elaborated.

A First draft of the multimedia format design has been developed by the R leader and shared with the partners. It is foreseen as a multimedia handbook, accessible online and offline. Its contents will be also accessible using a QR-code. It is designed as a Digital book which is meant to be easy and friendly accessible, while changing from one page to another.

Partners are now working on the contents definition. Intermediate deadlines have been slightly postponed while waiting for the curriculum R3 definition, in order to fine tune with also this project contents, thus facilitating a common ground and understanding.

Result 3 - DRONE Curricula

Although R3 is in the initial stages planning and ground work has already begun. We have developed a curriculum that includes content and materials on journalism, legislation, drone skills and careers, and a reportage guide. Users will also be able to use video tutorials that we will record as part of the materials. We are currently in the process of creating the working materials.

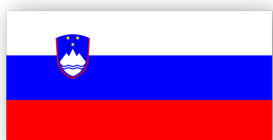

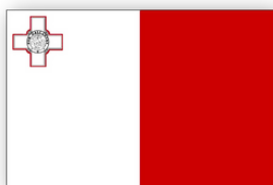
