Project Progress

Since the last newsletter was published in November 2022, the project has progressed positively. Two Transnational Partners Meeting's have been held in Cyprus and in Italy as well as an LTTA in Malta. The Drones incubator has been set up and new material developed in the project results is being uploaded. The aim of the incubator is to have a platform consisting of learning material developed during the project as well as additional videos and articles that may be useful to anyone doing the course. It is made up of three sections, training modules, course materials and the handbook. The incubator will also be available in six languages.

Since the last newsletter published two Transnational Partner's meetings took place, the first one took place in Nicosia, Cyprus between the 31st January and 1st February. The TPM in Cyprus was the second TPM of this project. This meeting was hosted by Enoros Consulting Ltd. During this meeting the partners finalised the first project result as well as discussing the next steps of the project. Another topic of discussion was planning the LTTA that was held in Malta in April.

The third TPM was held between the 29th & 30th of May in Bologna, Italy. 
